Pale Bau strengthens its position with four Komatsu machines

Two wheel loaders, a mobile excavator and a compact wheel loader with hydraulic quick coupler now make the Pale Bau GmbH fleet even more powerful. In close cooperation with the construction machinery dealer Kuhn, great attention was paid to environmentally friendly equipment.

Pale Bau GmbH, from the municipality of Fiss in Tyrol, recently acquired no fewer than four Komatsu construction machines from Kuhn. The two wheel loaders WA320-7 and WA320-8, the compact wheel loader WA70M-8 and the mobile excavator PW198-11 complete the family-owned company's well-stocked fleet. Around 25 people are employed. "We have always been very satisfied with our Komatsu machines. We already had five of the WA320 series wheel loaders in use at our company and they are a good example of how reliable Komatsu products are. It was therefore a logical consequence that we bought four more construction machines from this manufacturer," says Stefan Pale, owner and managing director of Pale Bau GmbH.

CONSISTENCY & RELIABILITY

The company was founded by Franz Pale, who passed it on to his son Alfred Pale. Stefan Pale, the third generation of the family business, is now in charge. "As far as our employees are concerned, we rely on a stable team that stands for reliability. Our partnership with Kuhn has been based on the same values for many years. With Kuhn sales manager Christian Moser and Kuhn salesman Josef Stöckl, we have two competent partners at our side whose commitment we greatly appreciate," says Stefan Pale.

Pale Bau GmbH is active in earthworks, demolition and recycling. Special requirements, such as walking excavator work, can also be fulfilled. This includes the construction of paths, as well as extensive earthworks for cable car construction with snowmaking systems and reservoirs. The company is fully committed to tackling unusual projects. For example, entire snow worlds were built for sporting games and flood-damaged villages were quickly freed from the debris flow.

WORKING IN HARMONY WITH NATURE

One of the two WA320 wheel loaders from Komatsu is used in the company's own building materials recycling plant, while the second is used on various construction sites. The PW198-11 wheeled excavator, which is a productive machine with a high lifting capacity, also works on construction sites. With its minimal swing radius

the implement is ideal for confined construction sites and road construction.

"The new WA70M-8 compact wheel loader is equipped with a hydraulic quick coupler. This means that the machine can be used in a wide variety of areas, whether with a sweeper, pallet fork or for clearing snow with a snow clearing bucket," explains Stefan Pale.

It is very important to the Tyrolean company to work in an environmentally friendly way. Two pillars are used here: At the start of construction, the vegetation cover is carefully lifted off and stored nearby, where it is cared for until it is returned. The second step is to integrate these grass tiles into the terrain. At the end of the construction work, the natural surface has completely regenerated. In terms of environmental friendliness, Pale BAU has found the ideal work equipment in the Komatsu machines. In addition to their high performance, they are also environmentally friendly. The WA320-8 wheel loader, for example, has an EU Stage V-compliant Komatsu engine, which is productive, reliable and efficient. Its extremely low emission values are very beneficial to the environment.
